Advice on Practical assistance

- 1. Overarching coordination of support in West Devon is being provided by West Devon CVS led by their Community Development Officer based in their Okehampton office. https://www.westdevoncvs.org.uk/news/ They have a leaflet "In Touch at Home in Tavistock" which lists all the services available to support people in the Tavistock part of the borough including the WDMC area. A copy is attached.
- 2. In Yelverton, Meavy, Sheepstor and Walkhampton we have access to YelverCare. To quote their website https://www.yelvertoncommunityprojects.org/yelvercare.html "During the epidemic, YelverCare is able to help those who are confined to their homes by:
 - a. collecting shopping
 - b. collecting prescriptions
 - c. arranging regular telephone chats to keep you in touch
 - d. providing transport for essential journeys (eg to the surgery)
 - e. dog walking
 - f. To arrange for any of these services, telephone 07775 695864 between 10 am and 1 pm Monday to Saturday."

3. In Horrabridge:
